## SPARKLING

- 2020 **Pétillant Naturel** Mersel Wines “Leb Nat Gold,” 16 · 64  
Bekaa Valley, Lebanon  
*From one of the oldest wine regions in the world, vinified from the indigenous Merwah and the well-traveled Viognier, this tastes like green apples, seaspray, and white apricots.*
- 2020 **Pétillant Naturel** Lise & Bertrand Jousset 'Éxilé' Rosé 16 · 64  
*Full of raspberry, wild strawberry and grapefruit notes, the Éxilé is bright, textured and delightfully juicy.*
- NV **Champagne 1er Cru** Hervé Rafflin "La Nature" 22 · 88  
Extra Brut, Chigny-les-Roses, Montagne de Reims  
*Crisp, complex, and refreshing grower Champagne, a blend of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, and Meunier, with lemon peel, baked bread, and ginger. Celebratory and sensational.*

## WHITE

- 2020 **Chardonnay** André Bonhomme "Mâcon Villages" 17 · 68  
Burgundy, France  
*The range from André Bonhomme represents some of the most dynamic and terroir driven wines from the Mâconnais. The wine overdelivers with incredible acidity, minerality and fresh citrus notes.*
- 2020 **Porta del Vento** 'Catarratto', Sicily, Italy 16 · 64  
*Marco Sferlazzo, of Porta del Vento, is considered the king of 'Catarratto'. His commitment to responsible farming and low intervention winemaking has elevated his status and changed the perspective of Sicilian wines. A perfect winter white - full in weight with guava, white peach, and rosemary notes.*
- 2020 **Sauvignon Blanc** Tetramythos 'Natur' 15 · 60  
Peloponnese, Greece  
*Sourced from some of the highest elevation sites in northern Peloponnese, the 'Natur' is full of pear, pineapple & candied orange notes with great minerality & texture. This wine has us yearning for rooftop imbibing..*

## ORANGE & AMBER

- 2020 **Roussanne Blend** Glassmaker "North Coast Orange," 16 · 65  
Sonoma, California  
*Predominantly roussanne with a touch of sauvignon blanc and chenin, the north coast orange has the perfect balance of bright citrus fruit with a captivating botanical element. .*
- 2019 **Garganega** La Bianca di Angiolino Maule "Sassaia," 17 · 68  
Gambellara, Veneto  
*Volcanic skin-contact Garganega, vibrant with oyster shells, orange zest, chalk, and seaspray—drink with seafood, or an ocean breeze.*
- 2020 **Grüner Veltliner** Jurtschitsch "Belle Naturelle," 15 · 64  
Kamptal, Austria  
*Based on the traditions of low intervention winemaking, meticulous vineyard management and the endless quest to produce complex and inspiring wines, Stefanie & Alwin Jurtschitsch are changing the perspective of Austrian wine. The 'Belle Naturelle' has the perfect balance of white pepper spice, bright citrus notes and herbaceous undertones.*

## RED

- 2020 **Gamay** Jean-Claude Lapalu "Vieilles Vignes," 15 · 60  
Beaujolais, France  
*Jean-Claude Lapalu has been a driving force in the natural wine movement throughout Beaujolais and beyond. His wines are textured, mineral driven, and focused with an underlying savory lift.*
- 2019 **Grignolino** Iuli "Natalin" 15 · 60  
Piedmont, Italy  
*Fabrizio Iuli is revitalizing the lesser known (and nearly extinct) varieties of Piedmont. The Grignolino is light in weight with a perfect balance of red berry, dried herbaceous notes and tannic grip.*
- 2020 **Syrah** Julien Cecillon 'Les Graviers' 17 · 68  
Rhône Valley, France  
*A blend of 3 different vineyard sites, the graviers is a homage to 'Place de Graviers' where Julien grew up. Medium in weight with dark berry fruit and salty savory notes.*

## ROSE

- 2020 **Rosé** (DRAFT) Clos Cibonne “Tentations,” Provence 15 · -  
*A refreshing and light-bodied drought of summer from one of our favorite Provençal winemakers.*
- 2020 **Côtes de Provence Rosé** Figuère 'Magali,' 15 · 60  
 Provence, France  
*A traditional blend of all native provençal grapes, the Figuère is lighter in style with wild strawberry, citrus and mineral notes.*

## AFTER DINNER

- NV **Vin de Bugey** Patrick Bottex 'La Cueille' 16 · 64  
 Savoie, France  
*Refreshing, pure and dangerously easy to drink, the Bugey checks all the boxes. Full of red berry fruit, elegant bubbles & just the right amount of sweet.*
- NV **Tawny Port** Quinta do Infantado '10yr' 16 · 120  
 Douro, Portugal  
*Tawny port at its finest – silky with notes of roasted hazelnuts, caramel & dried fruit.*

## WITHOUT ALCOHOL

- 0.0% **Verjus blanc** Wolffer Estate, Sagaponack, LI 11 · 34  
*Bright, easy, and Hampton-y.*

# BY THE BOTTLE

## SPARKLING

- NV **Frizzante Col'Fondo** Rarefratte "Còle," Breganze, Veneto 80  
H1 *Cristian Moresco Rarefratte works with the indigenous and lost varieties of Breganze; this sparkler, from the rare Gruaja grape, is racy and full of crunchy apples, with a surprisingly supple texture and an undercurrent of grain and biscuit.*
- NV **Sparkling Junmai Sake** Fukucho "Seaside," 69  
L4 **Akitsu, Hiroshima** (500ML)  
*Beautiful Champagne-method sake brewed from heritage rice, made by a woman toji (master brewer); this tastes like honeydew, lemon peel, and white flowers, with a mineral quality like snowmelt. Rare and special.*
- NV **Pétillant Naturel** Joao Pato 'Maria Duck' Bairrada, Portugal 58  
G1 *Feeling constrained by the standards of Bairrada winemaking, Maria Pato, created this project because of her love of the region varietals. This is technically a skin contact 'pet nat' - hazy, orange in color with grapefruit, mango and mineral notes.*
- NV **Champagne 1er Cru Blanc des Noirs** Vadin-Plateau 120  
L1 **'Renaissance' Extra Brut, Vallée de la Marne, France**  
*Yann Vadin is undeniably producing some of the finest examples of Pinot Meunier in the Marne. The Renaissance is textured, pure & full of green apple & red fruit notes.*
- 2015 **Champagne 1er Cru Blanc de Blancs** Flavien Nowack 250  
K7 **"Cru d'Origine Cuis-Extra Brut," Vandieres**  
*Simply spectacular, 100% Chardonnay from 40+ year old vines, vinified with a level of detail and complexity that belies the effervescent friendliness of the wine. Aged under cork for 5+ years. One of the more exciting Champagne producers working.*
- NV **Champagne Rosé de Saignée 1er Cru** Larmandier-Bernier 200  
L7 **Extra Brut, Vertus**  
*A darker, fuller-flavored sparkling rosé of Pinot Noir & Pinot Gris, bold and lively, tasting a bit like a bottled Negroni Sbagliato.*

## WHITE &amp; LIGHT SKIN CONTACT

- 2019 **Sauvignon Blanc** Hervé Villemade 58  
 K1 Touraine, Loire  
*The wines from Hervé Villemade are unmatched. He's undisputedly changed the perspective of Touraine and cultivated an inspired following. The sauvignon is medium in weight, full of green apple, almond and citrus notes.*
- 2020 **Roero Arneis** Bricco delle Ciliegie 'Almondo' 68  
 G7 Piedmont, Italy  
*Coming from one of the highest elevation sites in Roero, the Bricco delle Ciliegie is the pinnacle of arneis. Light to medium in weight with key lime, pineapple and white peach notes.*
- 2019 **Xarel·lo** (SHA-REL-LO) Enric Soler "Espenyalluchs," 124  
 11 Alt Penedès, Catalonia  
*Is Enric Soler the best winemaker in Spain? His whites—most exclusively from Xarel·lo, and showcasing the Burgundy-esque dimension and deliciousness the grape possesses in still wine form—make a strong case. Maybe the strongest is this bottling, which drinks a bit like 1er Cru Meursault shot through with sunshine, but with a character that's all Penedès.*
- 2018 **Chablis 1er Cru "Côte de Savant"** Domaine 47°N 3°E 120  
 J1 (Guillaume Michaut)  
*Michaut's wines are new to the US, which is the only reason we're able to offer this as easily as we do. Simply, this is stunning organic white Burgundy, oak-aged, with a savory mineral character that's telltale Chablis, but an oxidative, aromatic richness that speaks of long years ahead of it.*
- 2015 **Riesling (Off-Dry)** Rita & Rudolf Trossen 116  
 H4 "Lay Purus," Mosel  
*They're old school natural winemakers with 40+ years of experience, and it shows: opulent but precise, with dry slate, bright pears and apples, and smoked honey.*
- 2019 **Treixadura Blend** Adegado do Demo "Bitoku" 64  
 B6 Ribeiro, Spain  
*Adegado do Demo is bringing our attention back to Galicia. This husband and wife team is committed to the traditions of Ribeiro with a playful spirit and experimental approach. The 'Bitoku' is bright and mineral driven with a beautiful texture and depth..*



2016 **Carignan Blanc (and friends)** Domaine La Réaltière 128  
A1 "Cante Gau," Coteaux d'Aix en Provence  
*A spectacular, full-bodied southern French white, dense but energetic, with nuanced and evolving flavors, structurally and aromatically complex but fresh and versatile. From a rare (and wrongly maligned) grape, organically farmed. A future classic.*

2018 **Pinot Blanc** Amélie & Charles Sparr "Pensee" 70  
A7 Alsace, France  
*Amélie & Charles Sparr are pushing the boundaries and redefining what we can expect from Alsace. This fantastic expression of Pinot Blanc begs for food - medium in weight with mouth-watering acidity and vibrant citrus and herbaceous notes.*

## ORANGE & MORE SKIN CONTACT |

2019 **Müller Thurgau Blend** Schlossmühlenhof 52  
C7 "Das ist keine Orange," Rheinhessen  
*The rare orange wine that actually tastes like oranges, albeit dry ones, with a juicy, thirst-quenching structure and a sense of fun, from its bilingual Star Wars reference of a name on down.*

2020 **Viognier Blend** Kunoh 'Gerbera' 82  
Nelson, New Zealand  
*Japanese sommelier turned winemaker, Yuki Nakano is taking us on a journey with every cuvée. A blend of viognier, pinot noir & gewurztraminer, the gerbera is not what you'd expect from an orange, let alone one coming from New Zealand. His wines are thoughtful, precise & meant for exploration.*

2016 **Malagouzia** (MAH-LAH-WOO-ZIAH) **Tatsis, Macedonia, Greece** 88  
I4 *Fuzzy peach, elderflower, and a bite of ginger: a skin-contact wine anyone could love.*

2018 **Savagnin Blend** L'Imparfait "Macération" 80  
C1 Ontario, Canada  
*A rich and only subtly grippy blend of Savagnin, Gewürztraminer, Pinot Gris, and Chardonnay Musqué, an aromatic mutation of Chard that gives this a bit of a maple apple flavor offsetting the spicy, tart finish.*

2012 **Ribolla Gialla** Josko Gravner, Venezia-Giulia 174  
B4 *From the master of structured, skin-contact whites: deep, elegant, and serious.*

## ROSÉ &amp; ROSÉ-ISH

- 2017 **Vin d'Alsace** Binner "Si Rose..." 88  
 A5 *Adventurous. This is skin contact Pinot Gris and Gewürztraminer, which means a lot of people would call this an orange wine, and yet... just look at that beautiful blush color. Whatever you choose to call it, it's delicious, with explosive flavors of rose petals, warm tropical fruits, and ginger, and an elegance that belies its ripe flavors.*
- 2014 **Tibouren** Clos Cibonne "Cuvée Spéciale des Vignettes," 132  
 J7 *Côtes de Provence Cru Classé*  
*A limited wine, coaxed out of old vines of the heritage variety Tibouren and then aged under fleurette (the prettily Provençal name for an aging style like the "voile" of Jura or the "flor" of Sherry). Complex, age-worthy, and drinking beautifully now.*
- 2020 **Pinot Noir** Swick, Willamette Valley, Oregon 48  
 A4 *Winemaker joe swick - a character in his own right - is committed to "making wines as naked and raw as possible". Bursting with black cherry & raspberry notes, the Swick rosé is the perfect complement to most every setting.*
- 2020 **Pinot Noir & Chardonnay** Scotty-Boy! "El Sandweech!!!," 72  
 B1 *Santa Barbara, California*  
*Equal parts co-fermented carbonic maceration of the Burgundy stalwarts (hence the name), but there's nothing classic (or classy) about this: it's pure picnic juice. It's just a very grungy, druggy picnic.*

## RED

- 2019 **Mencía** Guímaro, Ribeira Sacra, Galicia 62  
 E1 *Mencía, the grape redefining the reds of Spain! While leaner in weight, the Guimaro delivers electrifying freshness and purity with red berry and black pepper spice.*
- 2018 **Spätburgunder** Harteneck, Baden, Germany 62  
 E4 *Spätburgunder aka pinot noir is definitely having a moment. Historically, temperatures have been too cold for spätburgunder to ripen, but with increasingly warmer vintages the production of red has increased throughout Germany. The Harteneck is bursting with red cherry, thyme & candied apple notes with radiant acidity & minerality.*

- 2019 **Aloxe-Corton** Claire Naudin "Les Crapousuets" 214  
 F1 *Nervy but profound Pinot from 110-year old vines from one of our favorite Burgundy winemakers, drinking beautifully now: the sort of wine that snaps you to attention.*
- 2018 **Nebbiolo Blend** Proprietà Sperino 'Uvaggio' 78  
 D4 **Piedmont, Italy**  
*Predominantly nebbiolo with a touch of vespolina & Croatina, the Uvaggio has all of the dried fruit & herbaceous notes we love from Piedmontese wine with a softer touch. There's the power & structure reminiscent of great Barolo with the elegance & freshness of Burgundy.*
- 2020 **Syrah** Domaine Romaneaux-Destezet (Hervé Souhaut), 98  
 D1 **Ardèche**  
*Souhaut makes some of our favorite new-school Syrah, with a concentration of black fruit, olive, and granite that recalls more exalted Rhône appellations but a lift and a nervy energy that recalls great Cru Beaujolais. (He makes a killer Gamay, too.) This is one of our go-to reds in the building: versatile, food-friendly, and unmistakable.*
- 2019 **Nerello Mascalese & Nerello Cappuccio** Girolamo Russo 82  
 F4 **"a Rina" Etna, Sicily**  
*It's safe to say that the wines from Giuseppe Russo have officially reached 'cult' status. The "a Rina" checks all the boxes with dried herbaceous notes, bright berry fruit with a smokey, mineral finish.*
- 2019 **Cabernet Sauvignon & Marselan** La Ferme Rouge 60  
 E7 **"La Petite Ferme Rouge," Rabat & Casablanca, Zaër, Morocco**  
*Powerful and warm, with elegant tannins, red and black fruit, and a whiff of smoke, or desert air.*
- 2019 **Field Blend** Hiyu Wine Farm "Tzum Feis - Spring Ephemeral" 180  
 I7 **Columbia Gorge, Oregon**  
*Influenced by 'the wild side of permaculture', winemakers Nate Ready & China Tresemer have pigs, cows, ducks & chicken roaming throughout their vineyards to control the vegetation. Their regenerative approach & holistic winemaking have propelled them into the spotlight & inspired a cult following. While the 'Spring Ephemeral' is a field blend of varietals that generally produce rich & robust wines, this cuvée is elegant & refined.*

## LARGE FORMAT

- 2016 Grüner Veltliner & Weissburgunder Gut Oggau 300  
 X3 "Timotheus," Burgenland, Austria (MAGNUM)  
*From a family project (that's the winemaker's sibling on the label), this intense, light-skin-contact white jumps at you with green pepper, lime, and white flowers.*
- 2012 Savagnin Ouillé Philippe Bornard "Les Chassagnes," 300  
 X8 Côtes du Jura (MAGNUM)  
*After nearly a decade of bottle age, this topped off Savagnin is showing a beautiful savory side, with ginger, toasted nuts, and spiced honey offsetting still-fresh orchard fruits and white flowers. Serious, but still playful enough for the fox on the label.*
- 2018 Tavel Rosé Château de Trinquedel (DOUBLE MAGNUM) 300  
 X2 *World class rosé from the only Rhône appellation devoted to rosé, dark in color but light in flavors, sophisticated but fun and delicious.*
- 2018 Pinot Noir Domaine Du Pélican 250  
 X4 Jura, France (MAGNUM)  
*Crunchy pinot from the French commune, Arbois. With impressive aromas of wild strawberry and red cherry, this medium-bodied red is supported by juicy acidity and supple tannin.*
- 2012 Côtes du Rhône (OUTSIDE CORNAS) Guillaume Gilles 200  
 X9 "Les Peyrouses" (MAGNUM)  
*100% Syrah from the flats of Cornas: feral but beautiful, exciting but with unplumbed depths, the wild essence of the Northern Rhône.*
