- 2020 **Rosé Pét-Nat** Lise & Bertrand Jousset 'Éxilé' 16 · 64
Full of raspberry, wild strawberry and grapefruit notes, the Exilé is bright, textured and delightfully juicy.
- NV **Champagne 1er Cru** Hervé Rafflin "La Nature'l" 23 · 98
Extra Brut, Montagne de Reims
Crisp, complex, and refreshing grower Champagne, a blend of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, and Meunier, with lemon peel, baked bread, and ginger. Celebratory and sensational.

WHITE

- 2020 **Chardonnay** Domaine Corsin "Mâcon Villages" 17 · 72
Burgundy, France
Notes of apple, ginger, kiwi and honeycomp. this chardonnay has a full mouth-feel with a refreshing tropical finish.
- 2016 **Fernao Pires & Arinto** Quinta Val de Capucha "Clima" 16 · 64
Lisboa, Portugal
A blend of Portuguese white varietals that offers a perfect balance of minerality and texture. Herbaceous notes with a hint of white peach translates like an Atlantic breeze in a glass.
- 2021 **Albariño** Do Ferreiro 19 · 82
Rias Baixas, Galicia, Spain
100% Albariño from rainy northern Spain. This wine is a classic expression of the region with notes of lemon grass, grapefruit and seaside mist.

ORANGE & AMBER

- 2019 **Sumoll Negre & Xarello** Costador "Orange de Noir," 16 · 64
Catalunya
Made from a blend of red and white grapes, this wine is technically a rosé. With a deep orange hue, the sumoll adds aromas of ripe stone fruit and the xarello balances it out with a touch of minerality.
- 2020 **Grüner Veltliner** Jurtschitsch "Belle Naturelle," 16 · 64
Kamptal, Austria
The 'Belle Naturelle' has the perfect balance of white pepper spice, bright citrus notes and herbaceous undertones.

ROSÉ

- 2020 **Provence Rosé** (DRAFT) Clos Cibonne "Tentations" 15 · -
A refreshing and light-bodied drought of summer from one of our favorite Provençal winemakers.
- 2021 **Txacolina Rosé** Ameztoi "Rubentis," Getaria, Spain 16 · 72
A classic wine from the Basque country. Grown on steep seaside vineyards and fermented in enclosed steel tanks that give this wine a fresh saline minerality and a slight effervescence.

- 2019 **Barbera d'Alba** Giovanni Almondo "Valbianchera," 18 · 76
Piedmont, Italy
Grown at a high elevation, this Barbera shows serious finesse with notes of delicate black cherry and plums backed by refreshing acidity and an elegant long finish.
- 2020 **Vinas Mora** Field Blend, "Barbba" (served chilled) 17 · 68
South Dalmatia, Croatia
A unique blend of Marastina, Plavina, Debit and Lasin grapes. Bursting with juicy cherries, with hints of chocolate and earthiness, the grapes are macerated, fermented and aged in old oak.
- 2020 **Côtes du Rhone** J.L. Chave "Mon Coeur" 17 · 70
Rhône, France
A full bodied 50/50 blend of Syrah and Grenache from the legendary Jean-Louis Chave's negociant project. Notes of dried fig and dates with a smooth spicy finish.

- NV **Vin de Bugey** Patrick Bottex 'La Cueille' 16 · 64
Savoie, France
Refreshing, pure and dangerously easy to drink, the Bugey checks all the boxes. Full of red berry fruit, elegant bubbles & just the right amount of sweet.
- NV **Tawny Port** Quinta do Infantado '10yr' 16 · 120
Douro, Portugal
Tawny port at its finest – silky with notes of roasted hazelnuts, caramel & dried fruit.

Zippy and off-dry

SPARKLING

- NV **Sparkling Junmai Sake** Fukucho "Seaside," 69
G1 Akitsu, Hiroshima (500ML)
Beautiful Champagne-method sake brewed from heritage rice, made by a woman toji (master brewer); this tastes like honeydew, lemon peel, and white flowers, with a mineral quality like snowmelt. Rare and special.
- NV **Pétillant Naturel** Joao Pato 'Maria Duck' Bairrada, Portugal 58
G2
Feeling constrained by the standards of Bairrada winemaking, Maria Pato, created this project because of her love of the region varietals. This is technically a skin contact 'pet nat' - hazy, orange in color with grapefruit, mango and mineral notes.
- NV **Crémant de Loire** Domaine Landron "Atmosphères" 72
G3 Extra Brut, Loire Valley, France
Opting to use Folle Blanche Pinot Noir and Chardonnay instead of extra Muscadet grapes, Joe Landron creates this elegantly refreshing sparkling wine. Dry, crisp and mineral driven.
- NV **Montlouis-sur-Loire** La Grange Tiphaine 78
K2 'Nouveau Nez' Extra Brut, Loire Valley, France
This sparkling Chenin blanc drinks as elegantly as a champagne with intensified notes of orchard fruit and a clean zippy finish.
- NV **Champagne 1er Cru Blanc des Noirs** Vadin-Plateau 120
L1 'Renaissance' Extra Brut, Vallée de la Marne, France
Yann Vadin is undeniably producing some of the finest examples of Pinot Meunier in the Marne. The Renaissance is textured, pure & full of green apple & red fruit notes.
- NV **Champagne Grand Cru, Blanc de Blancs** Waris-Larmandier 180
J1 "Les Particules Crayeuses" – Extra Brut
Simply spectacular, 100% Chardonnay, vinified with a level of detail and complexity that belies the effervescent friendliness of the wine. Richer hazelnut and brioche notes with a bright long finish.
- 2015 **Champagne 1er Cru Blanc de Blancs** Flavien Nowack 250
L3 "Cru d'Origine Cuis – Extra Brut," Vandieres
Simply spectacular, 100% Chardonnay from 40+ year old vines, vinified with a level of detail and complexity that belies the effervescent friendliness of the wine. Aged under cork for 5+ years. One of the more exciting Champagne producers working.

	<i>Another fantastic wine from Enric Soler made from 100% Xarello and also drinking like a Burgundy worth 3x the price. This one is reminiscent of a 1er Cru Meursault, once again with some extra Sunshine thrown in.</i>

	<i>A rich and only subtly grippy blend of Savagnin, Gewürztraminer, Pinot Gris, and Chardonnay Musqué, notes of maple & apple flavor offsetting the spicy, tart finish.</i>

	<i>This northern Italian chardonnay is made with half carbonic macerated grapes and half in direct press. The result is a fresh and funky wine with notes of candied tropical fruits and some woody vanilla undertones.</i>	

- 2018 **Maria & Sepp Muster "Erde," Steirerland, Austria** 152
 B2 *A blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Morillon that spends 12 months macerating on the skins before aging for another 20 in large wooden tanks. Fresh herbaceous and as cool as the bottle it comes in.*
- 2020 **Vermentino blend, Il Torchio "Stralunato" Liguria, Italy** 104
 C2 *Stralunato means moonstruck in Italian which is exactly how this wine will make you feel. An elegant blend of Vermentino with a bit of Moscato (don't worry its dry) to give a boost of floral aromas.*
- 2020 **Aligoté, Julien Altaber Burgundy, France** 102
 H2B *12 days of skin contact Aligoté. Notes of Apricot, lemon with the right amount of weight and grip.*

ROSÉ & ROSÉ-ISH

- 2017 **Vin d'Alsace Binner "Si Rose..."** 92
 A3 *Adventurous. This is skin contact Pinot Gris and Gewürztraminer, which means a lot of people would call this an orange wine, and yet... just look at that beautiful blush color. Very floral with notes of citrus and lychee.*
- 2020 **Pinot Noir Swick, Willamette Valley, Oregon** 58
 A2 *Winemaker joe swick - a character in his own right - is committed to "making wines as naked and raw as possible". Bursting with black cherry & raspberry notes, the Swick rosé is the perfect complement to most every setting.*
- 2020 **Nero d'Avola Sergio Drago "Rosa," Sicily** 78
 C3 *Slightly darker Rosé with smoky strawberry notes on the nose and a refreshing tart cherry finish on the palate.*
- 2020 **Pinot Noir & Chardonnay Scotty-Boy! "El Sandweechee!!!,"** 72
 D1 **Santa Barbara, California**
Equal parts co-fermented carbonic maceration of the Burgundy stalwarts (hence the name), but there's nothing classic (or classy) about this: it's pure picnic juice.
- 2020 **Grenache, Cinsault & Mourvède, Domaine de la Tour du Bon** 80
 J3 **Bandol, France**
A provence Rosé grown on limestone soils. Everything you want to drink at the beach. Light, crisp, and refreshing with a dry finish and a touch of spice.

RED

- 2019 **Grignolino Luli "Natalin"** 60
 D3 **Piedmont, Italy**
Fabrizio Luli is revitalizing the lesser known (and nearly extinct) varieties of Piedmont. The Grignolino is light in weight with a perfect balance of red berry, dried herbaceous notes and a tannic grip.
- 2019 **Chianti Classico Isole e Olena, Tuscany, Italy** 82
 E2 *From our favorite Chianti producer this Chianti is made from 100% Sangiovese and is bursting with black cherry notes and finely integrated tannins.*
- 2019 **Nerello Mascalese blend Etna Rosso SRC** 98
 E1 **Mount Etna, Sicily**
Grown on 100% volcanic soils this wine offers notes of crush blackberry a hint of smoke and punchy/earthy finish.
- 2018 **Côt (Malbec) Fabien Jouves "Amphore"** 92
 E3 **Cahors, France**
A lot of people forget that Malbec is originally from France but Fabien Jouves has not. This wine is aged in large clay tanks called Amphorae which lend to its silky smooth texture, dark fruit notes and earthy finish.
- 2019 **Pinot Noir Julien Altaber** 100
 D2 **Burgundy, France**
A silky smooth Pinot Noir. Unfiltered for some added complexity and a bit of funk!
- 2016 **Gut Oggau "Rot"** 160
 E2-B **Weinland, Austria**
A blend of Blaufrankish and Rothaus this wine offers everything you want from an Austrian red. Fruit forward with curnchy tannins and a wild funky finish.
- 2009 **Rioja Reserva, Lopez de Heredia "Viña Tondonia"** 155
 F2 **Rioja, Spain**
Spanish wines always provide a fantastic value. This wine is a pure classic medium+ body, a bit of the classic Tempranillo spice, and enough age so it shows serious complexity.

2014 Merlot/Cabernet Franc, Thierry Valette "Clos Puy Arnod" 110
 F1 Côtes de Bordeaux, France

Thierry Valette is one of the only producers in Bordeaux farming organically and biodynamically. Using the classic blend of right bank Bordeaux and adding new school low-intervention methods this a full bodied, earthy wine with lovely dried fruit notes and crushed flowers.

2019 Cabernet/Merlot Blend Hiyu Wine Farm 'Spring Ephemeral' 180
 F3 Columbia Gorge, Oregon

Dedication to regenerative farming has propelled this producer into the spotlight & inspired a cult following. While the 'Spring Ephemeral' is a field blend of varietals that generally produce rich & robust wines, this cuvée is elegant & refined

LARGE FORMAT

2016 Grüner Veltliner & Weissburgunder Gut Oggau 300
 "Timotheus," Burgenland, Austria (MAGNUM)

From a family project (that's the winemaker's sibling on the label), this intense, light-skin-contact white jumps at you with green pepper, lime, and white flowers.

2012 Savagnin Ouillé Philippe Bornard "Les Chassagnes," 300
 Côtes du Jura (MAGNUM)

After nearly a decade of bottle age, this topped off Savagnin is showing a beautiful savory side, with ginger, toasted nuts, and spiced honey offsetting still-fresh orchard fruits and white flowers. Serious, but still playful enough for the fox on the label.

2018 Tavel Rosé Château de Trinquedel (DOUBLE MAGNUM) 300

World class rosé from the only Rhône appellation devoted to rosé, dark in color but light in flavors, sophisticated but fun and delicious.

2018 Pinot Noir Domaine Du Pélican 250
 Jura, France (MAGNUM)

Crunchy pinot from the French commune, Arbois. With impressive aromas of wild strawberry and red cherry, this medium-bodied red is supported by juicy acidity and supple tannin.

2012 Côtes du Rhône (OUTSIDE CORNAS) Guillaume Gilles 200
 "Les Peyrouses" (MAGNUM)

100% Syrah from the flats of Cornas: feral but beautiful, exciting but with unplumbed depths, the wild essence of the Northern Rhône.
